FEE AGREEMENT

I (We),

hereby undertake to pay the fees and expenses in accordance with the applicable Liechtenstein attorneys' tariffs or pursuant to a separate agreement, but at least CHF 550.00 per hour for founding partner attorneys, CHF 500.00 for partner attorneys, CHF 440.00 for attorneys, CHF 320.00 for legal associates, CHF 180.00 for balance sheet accounting, CHF 150.00 for bookkeeping, and CHF 120.00 for secretarial work (plus the applicable VAT), regardless of whether any reimbursement of costs may be lower. If several principals grant the mandate in the same matter, they shall be jointly and severally liable for payment of the fees incurred in this matter.

Furthermore, I (we) undertake to pay a 3% lump-sum expense charge for postage, copies, archiving, telephone, etc. Travel expenses shall be charged as disbursements at CHF 0.70 per kilometre.

The contractor/authorized representative shall be liable for all damages culpably caused in the execution of a mandate within the entire contractual relationship limited to a maximum amount of CHF 2 million. Liability for slight negligence is expressly excluded, so that liability is limited to gross negligence and intent.

I (we) agree that my (our) personal data (names, addresses, email addresses, telephone numbers, etc.), as well as documents transmitted digitally or in analog form, may be processed and stored (scanned) using automated systems. This consent to data processing may be revoked at any time and also applies to data processing by Schatzmann Services GmbH (operating company). Such revocation shall not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out until that time. Attorney–client privilege shall apply.

The mandate does not include tax advice, unless this is expressly agreed in writing.

Furthermore, I (we) explicitly grant authorization and express consent that communication with me (us) and with third parties may take place via email. I (we) acknowledge that the use of electronic communication involves risks and that confidentiality cannot be guaranteed.

This fee agreement shall be governed by Liechtenstein law. The exclusive place of jurisdiction for disputes arising from this fee agreement or concerning its existence shall be Vaduz. The principal may also be sued before any other court having jurisdiction over him/her.
