



POWER OF ATTORNEY

I (We),

hereby grant power of attorney to the attorneys-at-law MMag. Dr. Dominik Schatzmann, Mag. Patrik Baur, MMag. Philipp Schnetzer, Mag. Tobias Stump and lic. iur. et rer. pol. Pius Heeb, and further authorize them to represent me (us) and my (our) heirs in all matters, in particular before judicial and administrative authorities, including all criminal matters, tax matters, land register matters, matters relating to public and other registers, matters in non-contentious proceedings, in enforcement and security proceedings, as well as before authorities and outside of court; to sell or acquire for consideration movable and immovable property and rights; to enter into loans or borrowings; to receive money or monetary value and issue receipts for the same; to initiate legal proceedings; to receive service of documents of any kind; to file and withdraw legal remedies of any kind; to conclude settlements of any kind; to accept or renounce an inheritance conditionally or unconditionally and to conclude inheritance partition agreements; to establish company agreements; to make gifts; to agree to arbitration and appoint arbitrators; to waive rights without consideration; to obtain information from banks and doctors (including psychiatrists, etc.); to substitute the granted power of attorney to one or more authorized representatives with equal or lesser rights; and generally to undertake all actions deemed necessary or useful for safeguarding my (our) interests.

This power of attorney shall remain valid even after my death (so-called transmortal power of attorney).

Furthermore, I (we) explicitly grant authorization and express consent that communication with me (us) and with third parties may take place via email. I (we) acknowledge that the use of electronic communication involves risks and that confidentiality cannot be guaranteed.

This power of attorney and the mandate relationship shall be governed by **Liechtenstein law**. The exclusive place of jurisdiction for disputes arising from the mandate and power of attorney shall be **Vaduz**. The principal may also be sued before any other court having jurisdiction over him/her.
